





Celebrating 50 Years of the Bala Lake Railway

Nestled amongst the mountains of southern Snowdonia and in the upper reaches of the Dee Valley the Bala Lake Railway this year celebrates a major milestone.

Built on part of the old railway that ran from Ruabon to Barmouth which was closed as part of the Beeching cuts, the Bala Lake Railway ran its first train in 1972, so in 2022 it is celebrating its 50th anniversary.

The little narrow-gauge steam engines that originally worked in Snowdonia's vast slate quarries take visitors on a nine-mile return journey between Llanuwchllyn and Bala, for the most part running alongside the largest natural lake in Wales - Llyn Tegid or Bala Lake - and affording stunning views across the lake to the nearby mountains.

Artefacts from the slate quarries and their associated railways are displayed in the railway's award winning Heritage Centre at Llanuwchllyn station. There's the chance to get up close with the engines that are not in use that day, and even to stand on the footplate of one of them.

The railway will be marking its silver anniversary with a series of events throughout the year, culminating in a steam gala over the August bank holiday weekend.




