One of the Great Little Trains of Wales

A little railway with big scenery

Nestled amongst the mountains of southern Snowdonia in the upper reaches of the Dee Valley lies the glistening waters of Llyn Tegid or Bala lake, the largest natural lake in Wales. Pause a while and you may hear a whistle piercing the tranquillity and soon after the chuffing of a little steam engine as it comes into sight. This will be one of the little Quarry Hunslet engines that once worked in Snowdonia's vast slate quarries, and now lovingly restored by enthusiasts.

Bala Lake Railway runs along the full length of the lake and beyond, often passing right by the water's edge. The nine mile return journey between Llanuwchllyn and Bala offers stunning views across the lake to the nearby mountains.

Artefacts from the slate quarries and their associated railways are displayed in the railway's award winning Heritage Centre at Llanuwchllyn station. There's the chance to get up close with the engines that are not in use that day, and even to stand on the footplate of one of them.

The railway runs a series of events throughout the year, including a steam Gala over the August bank holiday weekend. Other family events include a Day out with Alice the Little Welsh Engine - the real engine which is the star of a beautifully illustrated children's book by Pauline Hazelwood, scary Halloween trains and culminating with a visit from Santa in December. Last year the Bala Lake Railway celebrated its 50th anniversary.



A truly special place

From fairy-tale towers and a Victorian dam to breath-taking scenery and rare wildlife; Lake Vyrnwy is a truly special place.

You will find over 20km of walking trails, an abundance of wildlife, hidden sculptures and plenty of history and heritage to uncover. 2023 is the year to celebrate Wales' trails, from the old to the new. Lake Vyrnwy, hidden in the foothills of the Berwyn Mountains in Mid-Wales, offers a choice of five very different trails with spectacular views and wildlife.

The 'Wildlife Way', a short one-mile circular loop, takes you alongside the riverbank and meanders through sessile oak woodland. Or perhaps, the 'Wildlife Trail', a three-mile walk through forestry tracks and opens up to panoramic views of the lake, dam, hills and moorland is more inviting. In Spring, look out for pied flycatcher, redstart and goshawk along your way. A favourite for families and dog-walkers, the two-mile circuit along the river to the spectacular Rhiwargor Waterfall is definitely worth a visit.



The Slate Landscape of North West Wales becomes World Heritage Site



In 2021 the Slate Landscape of North West Wales became the UK's newest World Heritage Site, joining Machu Pichu and the Giza Pyramid amongst others. It also became the 4th World Heritage Site in Wales, alongside the Pontcysyllte Aqueduct, Blaenavon Industrial Landscape and the Castles and Town Walls of King Edward in Gwynedd.

The National Slate Museum is also a key part of the new designation. Based in the original Victorian Engineering Workshops of the vast Dinorwig Slate Quarry from its heyday in the 1870's to its closure in 1969, its magnificent structure is still breath-taking today and visitors marvel at live demonstrations of splitting slate and blacksmithing and the enormous waterwheel today.


By the 1890s the Welsh slate industry employed approximately 17,000 workers and produced almost 500,000 tonnes of slate a year, around a third of all roofing slate used in the world. Welsh slate was used on a number of buildings across the globe including Westminster Hall in London's Houses of Parliament and Copenhagen City Hall, Denmark. In 1830, half the buildings in New York had roofs made of Welsh slate!
